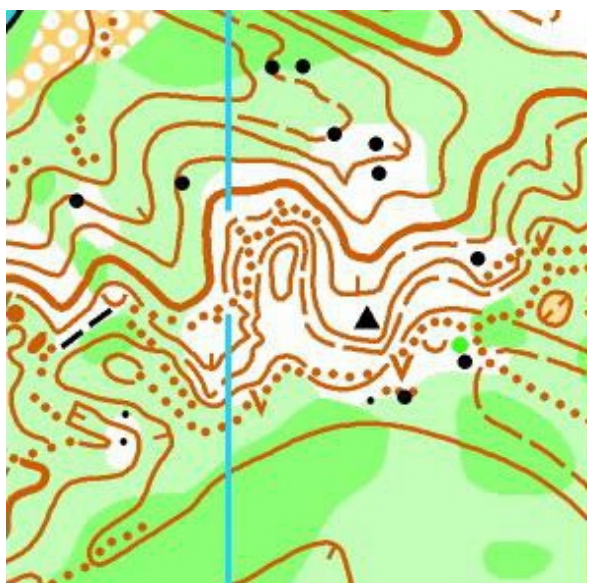

## ENTRY / PAYMENT

Organizers will bear all expenses for the organization of the Open Grodno Cup 2019. Participants themselves cover their expenses (travel, accommodation, food, entry fee). Entry at the event website **kronan.by** will be open in February 2019.

## PUNCHIG SYSTEM

SportIdent punching system will be used. It is allowed use personal SI-cards of any series.

SI-cards may be rented from the organizers for 2 Belarusian rubles (ca. 1 EURO) for all days.

## GPS-TRACKING

GPS-trackers will be used for M/W 21E. Live GPS-broadcasting will be available at arenas and online.

## MEALS

Expenses for meals are to be covered by the competition participants themselves.

It is possible to organize 3 meals a day at the cafeteria of the Kupalinka recreation center upon preliminary request

## TRANSPORT

The athletes may use personal or public transport.

Transportation may be provided by the organizers on all competition days by prior request.

## VISAS

IOF member federations that do not need visa to Belarus: Argentina, Azerbaijan, Brazil, China, Cuba, Ecuador, Israel, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Macedonia (invitation is needed), Moldova, Montenegro (invitation is needed), Russia, Serbia, Turkey, and Ukraine. Foreign participants may come to Belarus without applying for a visa.

All foreign participants may receive a free visa based on the invitation of the competition organizers, provided they apply for visa to **kronan@tut.by** no later than 1 month before the beginning of the competition.

## RESULTS

Overall team results are determined by the highest score in three disciplines of the program.

Team results in Relay are determined by the sum of points of the top 5 teams in any class.

Team results in Long and Sprint are determined by the sum of the top 10 team members in any class.

In case the points are equal, preference is given to the team that has the best result in Relay.

Winners and medalists in individual competitions and in Relay are awarded with diplomas, medals and memorable prizes.
